

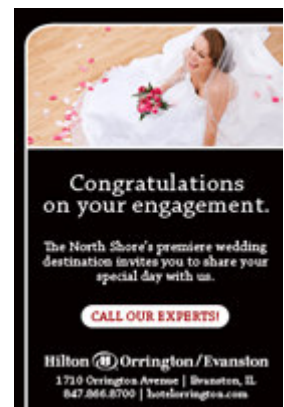


## Sculptures & Snapshots

The new exhibit, Ours to Fight For, explores and celebrates the achievements of Jewish men and women who were part of the American war effort both on and off the battlefield. In their own voices and through their artifacts, letters, and photographs, the "Greatest Generation" tells the stories of what the war was like for all its participants, and for Jews in particular. Approximately 500,000 Jews served in all branches of the U.S. armed forces during the war and 52,000 were decorated for bravery. Ours To Fight For brings to life the actions and feelings of these courageous young men and women - their discomfort, camaraderie, faith, fear, horror - and the deep meaning they found in getting the job done.
